All of our Camp Staff has undergone background checks and we have been approved by the New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene. They are also CPR/ First Aid trained.

Daily Schedule/Routine

Camp activities will rotate on a daily basis to ensure that your child has a unique and exciting experience. We like for our campers to try new and fun games and alternate our schedule so that your child can participate in all the activities that we offer!

How are campers grouped?

Superkickers Summer Campers are divided into age groups/grade levels. Summer Campers are grouped into no more than groups of 15 children with a 1:5 coach to student ratio for ages 2 to 5 (one Camp Coach, one Camp Assistant and one Activity Coach per group) and a ratio of 1:8 for ages 6 and up. (one Camp Coach and one Activity Coach per group). You can check on your Jackrabbit account which class your child is registered for. This years groups are listed below:

Can I request that my child be in the same group a his/her friend?

In order for your child to be placed with his/her friends they must be registered for the same days and times and must be of the same age groups. This does not guarantee the placement of all friends together at camp, due to the large volume of campers, but we will do our best to honor such requests.

What Should my Child wear to Camp?

Bathing Suit/Swimming Trunks, Camp t-shirt, shorts, sneakers/crocs. Sunscreen on water days.

Uniforms are required, we sell camp t-shirts on site for \$6 each. Rash guards uniforms are \$10 and we highly recommend kids to wear it on water day.

T-shirts can be bought at P.S.69 after May 1st

WE WILL NOT SELL T-SHIRTS ON THE FIRST DAY OF CAMP. CHILDREN WITHOUT THE PROPER UNIFORM AND KEYCHAIN WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO START CAMP!

Please **DO NOT** send your child with open toe sandals.

What to pack? (must be labeled)

Backpack
Lunchbox
Water bottle (Non- disposable preferred)
Lunch (if not having the School lunch provided)
Snacks
Change of clothes (Uniform Shirt please)

Towel, crocks, bathing suit, sunscreen for the water days.

Plastic bag for wet clothes

Napping mat (Pre-k campers that nap)

Is Breakfast/ lunch provided at SK Camp?

Breakfast is served to students that arrive at 8am. (No Exceptions). A hot Lunch is provided for the Full day Campers and served at 11:00am.

Note: For children with allergies please provide your own lunch/snacks and clearly label backpack with list of allergy foods. There is a peanut free table for children with peanut allergies.

Check in/Check out Procedures:

*Sign in/sign out with keychain. Your Child will receive a keychain that is going to be scanned at the camp entrance.

*Dismissal will be done outside the school at 3pm, 5pm and 6pm.

*Children cannot be dropped off before their scheduled time to arrive. We give a 15 min grace period for the 8am arrivals. After that you will only be able to drop off your child at 9am. Except for the pre-K students who should arrive at 8:45am to be dropped off before the older children.

Doors are open at 8am and then at 9am. Please be prompt. You cannot drop off your child between 8:10-9:00am. Except Pre-k kids that should be dropped off at 8:45am.

Trips

We provide 5 daily Trips for ages 5 and up during the Summer Camp. Trips are always on Thursdays this year and require a separate registration. The children who do not go on the trip have a regular scheduled day at Camp. We use a Yellow School bus to transport the Kids to/from the Trips.

On trip Days please:

- * Arrive at the school at 8am
- * have your child in uniform and comfortable shoes.
- * Send snacks/Lunch/two water bottles(we recommend that you freeze 2 plastic water bottles).
- *Send extra money for ice cream in a labelled envelope.
- * Pick up your child at 5pm at PS69.

Medical Procedures

All of our coaches are CPR/First Aid trained, and we have a medical director on site. You will be notified about any minor accidents through a accident report at the end of the day.. If needed we will contact you by phone.

We do not administer medications at Camp. If your child needs to take any medication, please administer it before bringing your child to camp. The only medication we are allowed to administer is the EPIPEN/allergy medication which will be kept under the supervision of the site supervisor.

Please DON'T send your child to camp if he/she has fever, if you do so, we will have to send your child back home. Children needs to be 48hrs fever free to attend. Also if vomiting, etc.. we will need a doctor's note from the doctor stating that the child is clear to attend the camp.

If your child has any allergies, PLEASE LABEL everything with your child's allergy information. (lunch box, back pack, etc)

Do I have to sign any forms if my child needs any special medical Treatment?

Yes, medical forms for the administration of EPI Pens and Asthma Medication/ Treatment are to be filled out by the parent prior to the child's entrance into the Camp. They can be filled out today. The Medications will be administered by the Health Director on site daily from 8am-6pm.

If my Child has Allergies what should I do?

Parents should inform the Camp Director of any Allergies the child has. Filled out any Medical Forms needed for the administration of EPI pens or any other Medication. Label your child's lunchbox with the list of food allergies. Send your Child's lunch from home.

Tuition, Make ups, cancellation Policies:

Payments: All Camp fees and tuition should be paid off by the first day of

Camp, July 5th.

EARLY DROP OFF/ LATE PICK UP:

Early drop off is provided for a \$50 weekly fee, and late pick up is \$10 for every extra hour your child stays. Camp closes at 6pm, after that a \$10 fee will be charged for every extra 10 minutes your child stays late.

MAKE UP POLICY

No make ups will be allowed except in case of illness and a doctor's note is required.

You will need to fill out the REQUEST FOR MAKE UP FORM and provide the requested documentation. The Director will have the last word in weather the child is eligible for a make up.

CANCELLATION POLICY

If canceling prior to May 31st, 2017 tuition is fully refundable, less the deposit. After May 31st, 2017, tuition is non-refundable. THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS. Only Credits with Super kickers will be given in the case of extreme/contagious illness or injury. A doctor's note is required.
